Summary: Hope Church is currently searching for a qualified Youth Pastor to minister to our youth, and to lead our youth ministry team. We are a growing multi-site church, and are currently ministering to 100+ middle and high school aged students and their families on a weekly basis between our two current campuses. The Youth Pastor is also responsible for overseeing Hope 56, our bridge ministry for 5th and 6th graders. The ideal candidate will be relationally minded, and someone who willingly invests in the lives of the next generation throughout the week, not just on Wednesday night and Sunday morning.
